RULES FOR DECORATING THE PANELS

The panels are plywood, cut 4' tall by 3' wide. They are cut in a simple shape evocative of a kimono, and are provided to the artists with a white primer applied. The size and shape of the panels may not be changed by the artists.

All panels that have been paid for by a third party sponsorship must recognize the sponsor within the design of the panel in letters at least 1" tall with sufficient contrast and visibility to be read from at least six (6) feet distance. Panels that have been self-sponsored may or may not have the sponsor recognition, as the sponsor wishes.

Panels may be displayed inside or outside and may experience poor weather. Also, panels may have various kinds of hanging equipment attached. Artists should decorate their panels appropriately.

Artists can use any design and any medium(s). All mediums and materials used in decorating the panels must be provided by the artist(s). No funds will be provided by CSDF other than the \$100 stipend provided by the third party sponsor.

Panel decorations must meet general standards of community-wide acceptance. Artists must be aware that once the panels are submitted to the CSDF, use of the panels is under the control of the CSDF, including the possibility that any given panel may not be used at all. By submitting a panel, artists transfer all rights in their panels, including all copyright, to CSDF. (Artists retain the joint right to use the panel's image in their own marketing programs.)

Panels may be purchased before, during, and/or after the Sister Cities event. In all cases, purchasers must agree to leave their panel in the CSDF's possession until after the celebration. CSDF retains the right to set prices for all panels, and to organize and control all elements of any sale. CSDF will divide the proceeds from any sale as follows: 50% of the sale price will be retained by CSDF; 50% will be paid to the artist(s) or organization of record who decorated the panel.

WHO MAY PARTICIPATE

Panels may be decorated by artists, groups, or organizations of any kind. It is intended that panels generate revenue for the Colorado Springs Diversity Forum (CSDF), the organizing sponsor of the event. To accomplish this goal, panels will be sponsored by various individuals, organizations, and businesses, although participants can sponsor their own panels.

How?

Shaped and primed panels may be acquired in one of two ways:

THIRD PARTY SPONSORSHIP

An individual or organization may sponsor a panel by donating \$200 to the CSDF, earmarked for the Kimono Panels. \$100 of this donation will be used by the Diversity Forum to pay for supplies and advertising associated with the Everybody Welcome™: A Celebration of Culture and Diversity, Fire Festival - 50th Anniversary Sister Cities Celebration event. The other \$100 will be given to an artist or group as a stipend for decorating a panel. The donor will receive recognition of their donation in Everybody Welcome™: A Celebration of Culture and Diversity, Fire Festival - 50th Anniversary Sister Cities Celebration event marketing materials.

SELF-SPONSORSHIP

An individual or organization may sponsor their own panel by donating \$100 to CSDF. In this case, the \$100 will be used by CSDF to pay for supplies and advertising associated with the project. The individual or organization will not receive a stipend for decorating the panel. The donor will receive recognition of their donation in Everybody Welcome™: A Celebration of Culture and Diversity, Fire Festival - 50th Anniversary Sister Cities Celebration event marketing materials.



IMPORTANT DATES

Panels may be sponsored at any time. Panels will be available beginning **January 2, 2012**. Completed panels must be delivered to CSDF no later than **June 1, 2012**.
